# Praying for Rain!

I also hear many people say that they are praying for their churches -"praying for rain", so to speak. But are we preparing our "fields" for when the "rain" comes?

Our Emmaus community is one such place that should be ready for when the rain comes. Pray for our community, for the community of our churches, but most importantly - keep praying for "rain".


