A Christmas Devotion from our Spiritual Director

Light is such a powerful image of God. According to the Hebrew Bible "light" was the first of God's creations (Genesis 1:3). God saw the light was good and separated it from darkness and so polarity and paradox were born!

In the New Testament, the gospel writer John would write about Jesus of Nazareth, "What has come into being in Him was life, and the life was the light of all people. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it." (John 1:4-5) Light and life are intimately interwoven. Jesus came as the Light of the World to reveal God's love for the whole world and God's presence with us. Jesus is Emmanuel, God with us. We can face all things if we truly trust and know that God is with us, we are not alone. Jesus told his disciples: "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life." (John 8:12) In the words of Isaiah: "O house of Jacob (church), come, let us walk in the light of the Lord!" 
