Musicians Beat

Bob McFarland has been a "regular" player with the Georgetown Emmaus Community for many years, playing acoustic guitar and joining in vocals. Besides playing acoustic guitar, Bob plays steel string and nylon string acoustic guitar, rhythm and lead electric guitar, fretted and fretless bass guitar, upright bass, mandolin, 4 string banjo, autoharp and hand percussion instruments. "I started guitar lessons when I was 8 and I'm now 63 and still playing. At 15 I joined a very successful garage band called The Egyptians. We recorded 4 songs - 2 of which I wrote - and made a lot of money (thanks especially to my dad who was our manager). I played in 2 other rock bands in college but didn't make as much money..... mainly because dad wasn't our manager.;-) "

Bob joined St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Ventura, CA in 1998. Along with his wife, Suzanne, they formed the first Contemporary Christian Music band at St. Paul's. "We were a 6 piece band named Labyrinth and we were together for 6 years." Bob also had designed and installed sound systems for various churches in Ventura.

Bob and Suzanne moved to Georgetown in 2006 where Bob joined the praise band, The Stirring, at First United Methodist Church. Bob gives of his time and talents weekly for the group by providing the musicality for the musicians - selecting the best key for singing, arranging Chord Charts in that key and providing lyrics for the band. "I do this from listening to recorded tracks - typically from YouTube or CDs. Occasionally I'm asked to create a contemporary arrangement for a traditional hymn."


