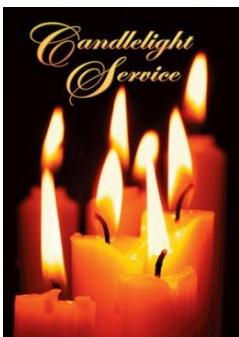
Fourth Day Speaker: Terry France
