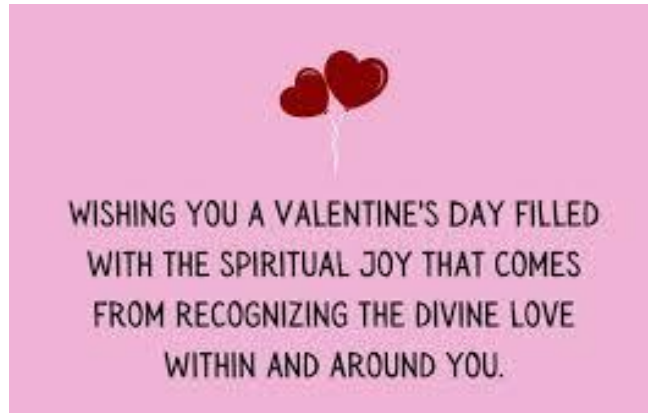

Greetings From Your Lay Director

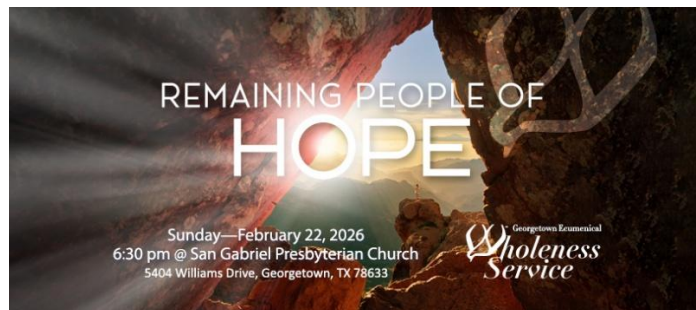

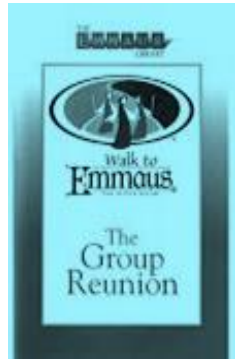
