New Glen Lake Policy

Staff and volunteers at Glen Lake have begun to paint all the cabin doors. One of the biggest problems they came across was removing all the goo from tape used to hang signs and information on the doors. Therefore they have a new policy. **No adhesives are to be used on the metal doors.** This includes masking tape, duct tape, self stick materials, two-sided tape, anything with an adhesive material. They will provide soft magnetic pieces to hang information. Please be sure that any Emmaus event complies with this policy and uses only the magnetic materials - no adhesives of any kind.
