

The *Walk to Emmaus* program is a carefully designed process. Each aspect of the weekend "Walk" as well as each aspect of the overall program is designed to build on and reinforce one another. The objective of this process is to cultivate spiritually vibrant church members, particularly leaders, who serve their local church with passion out of a Christ-like servant heart.

When Emmaus becomes primarily associated with one aspect of the overall experience rather than to the overall program, the objective of the program is thwarted and the underlying purpose of the program is lost. Rather than producing spiritually vibrant church leaders, "Emmaus" becomes an end in itself. It becomes an alternative worship experience (candlelight) or a substitute for involvement in the local church. It becomes a source of not-so-subtle spiritual arrogance.

"What" we do is important. "Why" we do it is even more important.


