

Trusting God for the Future

Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you. 1 Peter 5:7

By far the hardest of the Bible's commands for me to obey and live out are "Don't worry about anything" and "Rejoice always." It's not because I think they're wrong. I know the truth – nothing kills joy faster than worry! But we all worry, and some of us are really good at it. Some people just worry about their health; some just worry about their kids; some just worry about finances. But some of us worry about absolutely everything! If there were jobs for professional worriers, some of us could earn money – we're that good at it!

It's impossible to be joyful and full of worry at the same time – they cancel each other out. So, if you are among the constant worriers, anxiety has you in its death grip. All that worry is choking out the joy in your life. Remember our definition of joy: it is the settled assurance that God is in control of all the details of my life, the quiet confidence that ultimately everything is going to be all right, and the determined choice to praise God in all things.

Our antidote to worry is trust. Trust that God is in control of all the details of our lives. Our trust leads to confidence that it will all be okay – not that everything will turn out the way I want it to, but that God is at work in the details. Trust will loosen that death grip of worry and allow joy to flow back into your life. As a friend of mine said, "When you're worrying, you're not trusting, and when you're trusting, you're not worrying."

. . . Friends, bad things happen. This is earth, not heaven. I can't deny the reality of all that could go wrong and perhaps has already gone wrong. But as 1 Peter 5:7 says, we can throw the whole weight of our concerns upon God for we are his personal concern. We can find the peace that comes from trusting God; and when our hearts are at peace, joy returns.

UPCOMING CENTRAL TEXAS WALKS

Due to concerns of the Covid 19 virus, the Central Texas Emmaus Board made the very difficult decision to postpone the remaining walks for 2020. We will assess the situation for the February walk in 2021 when the time arises. In the mean-time think about how we can keep the fire alive in Emmaus.
