Georgetown Emmaus Decision to move to In-Person Gatherings

Thank you, Thank you, Thank you to those who attended our June 20th Emmaus gathering. We had a very productive ZOOM gathering...*for our <u>last</u> ZOOM meeting!* During the business meeting at the June 20 Gathering, we had in attendance "15" representatives from our Georgetown Emmaus community. We discussed going back to "in-person" gatherings and it was approved by unanimous consensus to return on July 18, 2021 to "in-person" gatherings. The following issues were discussed and agreed upon by consensus:

- Meet at St. John on July 18 and in October; and First Church on August 15 and in November; and Wellspring on September 19 and an undecided date in December.
- In July, we will meet at St John's sanctuary and "No" agape feast (meal)
- In August, we will meet at FUMC in the McKinney Center rooms 1001 and 1002 (the building across the street from the sanctuary). We anticipate we will have an agape meal and will confirm at our July gathering.

- In September, we will meet at the Wellspring sanctuary and we will plan to have an agape meal.
- The churches have no restrictions related to COVID and therefore, the Emmaus gatherings are in consensus that:
 - No masks will be required, no proof of vaccination is required. Social distancing will be encouraged but not guaranteed. Singing with masks will be optional, and social distancing is a personal choice during singing and the gathering.
- No "hybrid gatherings". It was determined that it would require equipment and expertise that is likely not available to do a ZOOM at an "in-person" meeting. The consensus was to just go back to in-person meetings.
- Each person being responsible for bringing their own sanitizing liquid, if they choose.
- There was a question about a screen and projector and about pianos. Pianos are available in each of the church settings. The Emmaus Community owns a screen and projector that can be brought to each meeting, so it will not need to be supplied by the sponsoring church.

Thank you Karen Lowery for being a wonderful secretary to record the final decisions to the many questions that we had. Again, thank you all for your attendance and thoughtful input to these decisions. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact our leadership team!

We do need 4th day speakers for July, September, and October. Please discern where God is calling you to share your witness. Also, "**Save the Date**" - Georgetown will be the sponsoring community for Walk #460 on October 7-10, 2021 at Greene Family Camp. We hope you can help us with agape and support!




AGAPE for Walks


