From our Spiritual Director, Rev. Dr. Ann Hagmann

Dear Sisters and Brothers, Co-Experiencers on this Walk to Emmaus.

As I sat down to write this devotional word of encouragement, I glanced at the base of the paper and found a Scripture, *John 1:4 "In Him was life, and the life was the Light of all people."* Indeed, Jesus is the life that became the Light for millions of Christians for the past 2000 years!!! Amen??!

Friends, we have all found life and Light in Christ. Our Emmaus experiences have taught us how loved and treasured we are by God and others. And how Christ counts on us to be His hands and feet, hearts and shoulders for others, even strangers and those in the worst of need. Jesus put it in an image *Matthew 5:14-16* records, where Jesus tells His followers: "You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand and it gives light to all the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven."

If we are to be lights of the Light, what does that look like? It means the things important to Jesus are important to us. What was at the top of Jesus' list? Love, value, and respect. Jesus loves everyone which meant Jesus valued women, children, tax collectors, prostitutes, fishermen, every sort of person including enemies and those who mistreated Him. As lights we are called to do the same. And it can be tough. I have been observing stay-at-home orders and venturing out only for occasional pick-up orders, bank, post office, and drives. A few hours ago, I went out to the bank and

post office. I decide to catch gas on the way home. As I was filling my tank, a truck pulled up on the other side of the gas pumps. As the driver exited his car, he spat onto the medium between us. A few minutes later while gassing his vehicle, he sneezed a couple of times (and I was glad there was a gas pump between us!!). My initial response was to be grossed out and think he was thoughtless and crude. When I reflected on what Jesus would do (sorry for the true but old cliché), I knew my hostility needed to change to acceptance. We never had eye contact; he never looked my way, so he saw neither my hostile eyes nor my accepting eyes. But God did and I did.

How's your light shining during these dark times? I'm sure many of you are a beacon of hope and love to others. Please don't find this as a time to cut others off, or to project your own fears and frustration onto others, but rather let it be a time to reach out and help, to **be strong – be kind** so that others will know Jesus' love and light through us. May it be so!

AGAPE LOVE

Agape, and its verb form agapao, is one of the several Greek words for love. The Bible also mentions *phileo*, or brotherly love, and refers to *eros*, erotic love. The Greeks also spoke of *storge*, which is a love between family members.

Agape love is a little different. It is not a feeling; it's a motivation for action that we are free to choose or reject. Agape is a sacrificial love that voluntarily suffers inconvenience, discomfort, and even death for the benefit of another without expecting anything in return. We are <u>called</u> to agape love through Christ's example: "Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God" (Ephesians 5:1-2).

Although <u>1 Corinthians 13</u> is known as the chapter on love, there is no book that speaks more about *agape* than 1 John. Two important themes come out of 1 John. The first is that it is inconsistent and false to claim we *agape* love God while not *agape* loving other believers. We cannot love God without loving brothers and sisters who also love Him. The second is that it is inconsistent and false to claim we *agape* love God if we don't obey Him. It is impossible to love God while ignoring what He says. The two are inextricably connected, as <u>Galatians 5:14</u> says: "For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'"
