From our Spiritual Director, Rev. Dr. Ann Hagmann: Hello fellow Emmaus journeyers. I pray this message finds you with hearts full of gratitude for your blessings and full of love for others. It can be a challenge!! But with God's grace and presence all things are possible. I mean really, on one level we are all miracles living in the midst of a Miracle! But I want to direct our thoughts for the rest of the year in a different direction.

A few months ago, Ann Bell brought me 4 DVDs to view for their structure. One was Philip Yancey's "The Jesus I Never Knew." I only saw the first session, but it was awesome! Yancey paints a 3-dimeninal picture of Jesus, in contrast to the two dimensional we have been taught. This Fall and Advent season I invite us to focus our eyes on Jesus. It would be a great idea for all of us to journal reflections on the "The Jesus I know." Ideas could be:

- When did you first remember learning about Jesus? Describe Him? How did your understanding change and grow over time? How did movies or films influence your picture and understanding of Him? Where is Jesus in your Christmas?
- Read the opening chapters of the Gospels. How are they different? What pictures do Matthew and Luke paint? Apply labels to the people and situations to help you flush out the 3-dimenional Jesus. Leave Hollywood out of it; Who was Jesus, really? For example, He was a refugee into Egypt to escape death. He lived in an occupied country.

If some of you are interested in doing this, I think it would be great to incorporate a sharing about "The Jesus I know" at our special Christmas gathering.
