Dear Emmaus Co-Journeyers,

"Listen, do you hear it?" Listening is a critical part of our life – half of our communicating. When I would counsel couples for marriage, I always talked about the importance and criticalness of communication in a relationship. Communication involves honest expression of ourselves to one another, as well as listening to them. We all need self-evaluation of our listening skills. How much time do we spend listening to the world around us? Listening to God? Listening to Nature? Do you listen to the people around you – their actions as well as words?

Why don't we try focusing on listening this Fall? Listening to God, to our family and friends, and even to our enemies or those we politically disagree with. We might be amazed at what we can learn when we listen. Paul made this remarkable statement – "Listen and I will tell you a mystery. We will not all die but we will all be changed. For this perishable nature must put on imperishability, and this mortal body must put on immortality. Then the saying that is written will be fulfilled, death has been swallowed up in victory, where oh death is thy victory? Where o death is thy sting? But thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Corinthians 15) Happy listening!
