From our Spiritual Director, Rev. Dr. Ann Hagmann:

Fellow travelers, if you are like me, you may find it hard somedays to “do it all,” “to stay on top of everything,” “to always be upbeat,” ... Sometimes I find I need endurance in hope, endurance in faith, endurance in love to live my life in grace. Paul wrote to the Romans about justification and grace. He told them “Therefore, since we are *justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have obtained **access to this grace in which we stand***” (5:1-2). We have **a way to grace**, and not only to grace but to **stand in it**. We simply have to be *open to it and receive*; we have to *Let Go and rest in peace*, assured that God is with us, We are not alone. God's peace transcends circumstances and suffering. Paul goes on to say that “suffering produces **endurance**, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and **hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us**” (vv. 4-5). *God's love, the power and presence of the Holy Spirit, will give us strength* and bring us through our daily struggles and our perennial struggles. *Rest and receive it, **Stand in grace*** and continue to live a life **enduring in love** to God, others, and the wondrous Creation that surrounds us.
